## Workgroups

- The *Assessment Workgroup* - maintains and updates the Coalition's Needs and Resources Assessment, in accordance with Texas Department of State Health Services requirements.
- The *Outreach and Education Workgroup* - recruits and welcomes new coalition members and engages in community outreach and development. This workgroup will include the Speaker's Bureau, which will execute community presentations, and represent the Coalition at public events such as health fairs and community meetings.
- The *Sustainability Workgroup* – oversees the sustainability and self-sufficiency of the coalition, identifying and addressing capacity issues such as leadership, structure, and funding.
